You become someone who **ships real AI software.**

You served. Now you build. This program turns the discipline, judgment, and operational mindset you earned in uniform into a new skill: designing, building, securing, and deploying production-grade AI systems. You graduate with a portfolio of real, working software and the proof to back it.

OPERATE AN AI-AUGMENTED WORKSPACE

Set up and run a development environment integrating coding assistants, agents, and automated workflows.

BUILD & DEPLOY WITH AI

Design, build, and deploy production-grade AI software by directing and reviewing AI-generated code.

GROUND AI IN REAL DATA

Use retrieval to ground AI in real business knowledge, and prove output quality through an evaluation discipline.

AUTOMATE & BUILD AGENTS

Build workflows, automations, and autonomous agents that integrate with real business systems.

PROVE THE ROI

Analyze workflows to find where AI delivers measurable value and produce defensible business cases.

SHIP A REAL CAPSTONE

Complete a real-business capstone with documented outcomes and a structured industry internship.

What This Program Is

A comprehensive pathway from AI and internet foundations to shipping production-grade, AI-powered software that delivers measurable business value. You learn to direct and review AI-written code rather than write every line yourself, building a portfolio of deployed systems as you progress, and finishing with a real-business capstone and a structured industry internship.

Veterans and service members ready to move into a high-demand civilian career. No technical background required. The discipline, problem-solving, and operational mindset you built in service are exactly what this program builds on. We add the technical skill, you bring the work ethic.

8 COURSES · 24 CREDITS · TWO SEMESTERS

Built in Sequence

Every course builds on the last and closes with a real, deployed deliverable. Semester one takes you from foundations to grounded, agentic systems.

COURSE 1 · 3 CR

AI Foundations & the Modern Internet

Thinking frameworks, how AI works (tokens, context, failure modes), internet literacy (HTTP, DNS, REST, auth), multi-tool literacy, and a first Model Context Protocol install. Closes with a Technology Map of a real business.

COURSE 2 · 3 CR

AI-Powered Software Architecture

A hands-on build course: AI writes the code while you architect, direct, review, secure, and deploy. Web foundations, a frontend framework, an Express + MongoDB + JWT backend. Closes with a deployed app integrating the Claude API and an MCP server, defended in an oral review.

COURSE 3 · 3 CR

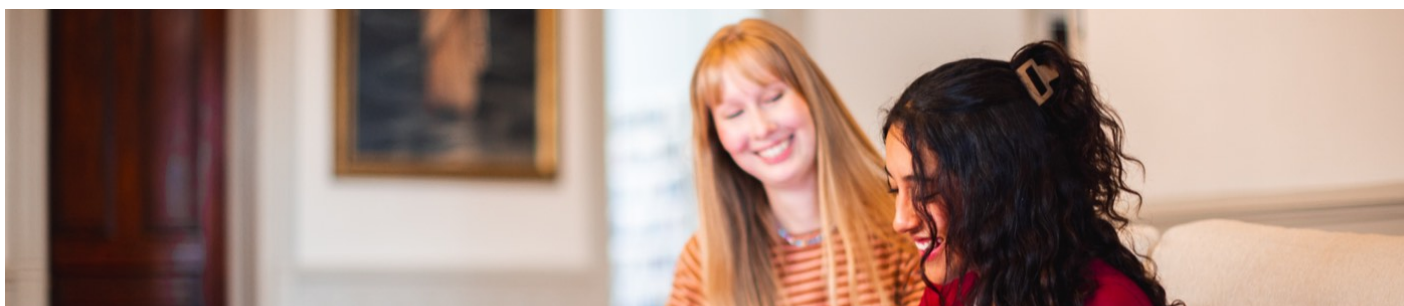
Grounded AI Systems: RAG, Evaluation & Production

Give AI trustworthy access to a business's own knowledge: real data, embeddings, vector stores, the RAG pipeline, citations, an evaluation discipline, and production hardening. Closes with a deployed Grounded Knowledge System exposed as an MCP tool.

COURSE 4 · 3 CR

Agentic AI: Automation, Agents & MCP

Make AI act: orchestration and reusable skills, automation platforms and patterns, the agent loop and autonomy levels, and building and deploying an MCP server with enterprise patterns. Closes with a governed Agentic Automation System.



FROM PRODUCT TO PLACEMENT

The Capstone Arc

Semester two turns skill into proof: a designed product, a real business case, a measured capstone, and an industry internship.

COURSE 5 · 3 CR

AI Product Design & Growth

Make it usable, beautiful, and able to grow: UX and usability, visual design, accessibility, multimodal asset production, and an owned, automated growth surface (lifecycle email, landing pages, SEO). Closes with a designed product and its growth machinery.

COURSE 6 · 3 CR

Business Systems & AI Consulting

The ROI reveal: discovery and user research, opportunity heuristics, business economics, ROI methodology, marketing strategy and metrics, and smart dashboards. Closes with a business case on a real business and an approved capstone scope.

COURSE 7 · 3 CR

Capstone: ROI in the Real World

A complete AI implementation for a real business with measured value, through a mandatory security audit gate. Produces a deployed system, before-and-after metrics, a case study, a security audit report, and a recorded presentation.

COURSE 8 · 3 CR

Career Launch Internship

A part-time industry internship (around 100 hours) concurrent with the semester, plus career preparation, mock interviews, and reflection. Produces a verified placement, a supervisor evaluation, and a Career Launch portfolio.

How This Program Works

No lectures to sit through, no tests to cram for. You learn by building real systems and proving you understand them.

Mastery-Based

You move forward by demonstrating you can do the work, not by logging seat time. Every course closes with a real deliverable and a review that verifies you understand what you built.

Is This Right for You?

This isn't a list of requirements. It's an honest look at what separates the students who thrive from the ones who struggle.

You Can Write Clearly

Much of this program is written work: analyses, client-facing documents, case studies. You don't need perfect grammar. You need to explain complex ideas so a busy person follows your reasoning in one read.

You Can Protect the Time

Self-paced does not mean no time. It means hours that are genuinely yours, or that you're willing to free up. Be honest with yourself about the hours before you start.

You Can Change Your Mind

This program challenges what you believe about AI, technology, and your own abilities. Students who thrive treat every belief as a hypothesis to test, not a position to defend.

You Can Sit with Confusion

Every week puts you somewhere you don't fully understand. That's by design. The students who thrive try something, read the error, and try again, instead of waiting to be told the answer.

You're Comfortable with a Computer

You don't need to know how to code. You do need to install software, navigate a file system, use a browser beyond the basics, and type at a reasonable speed.

You Have a Specific Reason

Students who finish have a reason beyond "this sounds interesting": a career they're building toward, a gap they're closing. Know what you're working toward.



What Does NOT Matter

- **Your MOS or branch.** The program starts from scratch.
- **Your degree, or lack of one.** Service experience counts here.
- **How long you've been out.** The skills you built transfer directly.
- **Whether you've used AI before.** Course 1 covers that.

MENTORING & WORKSHOPS

Optional live workshops and mentoring throughout, plus direct support through the parts where you get stuck.

CAREER PREPARATION

Course 8 builds in mock interviews, reflection, and a Career Launch portfolio, not as an afterthought but as part of the program.

REAL BUSINESS WORK

You don't just build practice projects. The capstone is a real implementation for a real business, with measured value.

VERIFIED INTERNSHIP

A structured industry placement of around 100 hours produces a supervisor evaluation and real workplace experience.

This certificate is awarded by V School, the program's credentialing partner. You earn it through for-credit coursework at Southern Virginia University, a private liberal arts university in Buena Vista, Virginia, accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC).

SVU's accreditation is what makes the coursework for-credit and the credential real. You earn university coursework backed by a real institution, a V School certificate, a teaching team, and a curriculum built around real, deployed work, inside a close-knit, values-driven community.

PREREQUISITE

Complete the Applied AI Foundations Assessment before enrolling. No prior coding experience required.

The certificate runs over two semesters. You may begin in Fall, Spring, or Summer, subject to SVU's published academic calendar.
